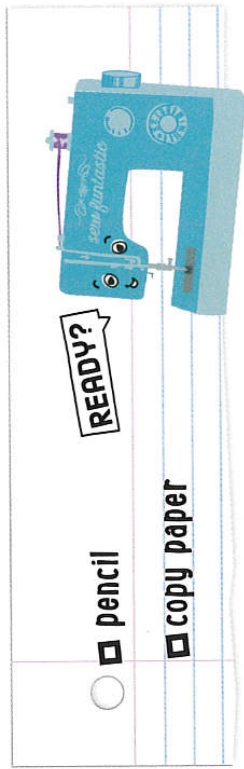


MOUSE PIVOTS

Stitch a path for the mouse to find the cheese.

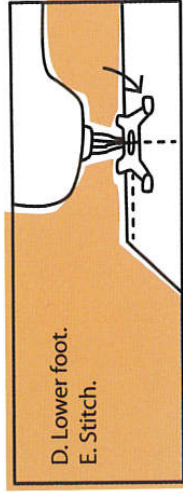
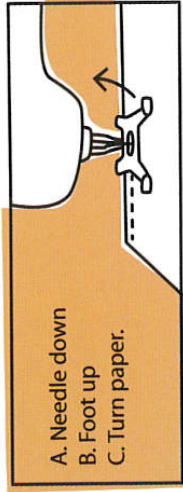


Place copy paper over the rectangle below and trace, or download and print the page. (Refer to About This Book, page 5.)



1. Place the paper with the design under the presser foot. Lower the needle into position at the mouse. Stitch on the line. Stop at the first corner.
2. To pivot: Leave the needle down in the paper. If the needle is up, turn the flywheel by hand to put the needle down. Lift the presser foot. Swing the paper around and lower the presser foot. What an awesome pivot!

To Pivot



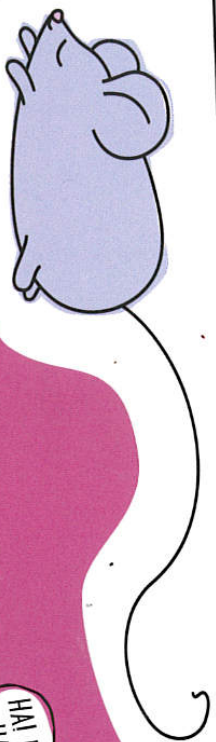
3. Stitch to the next corner. Pivot again.



4. Play, practice, and enjoy stitching on the lines. Raise the presser foot to remove the paper. Is your thread take-up at the highest position? Did your mouse find the cheese?
