

History road

- 1 This time begin by organising the events into correct chronological order and number them off.
- 2 Draw a road or path – thicker at the foot of the page (or board) and tapering off into the distance at the top of the page. Put a few bends in it.
- 3 Place the earliest event (the most distant) on or beside the road at the top of the page.
- 4 Place the most recent event at the start of the road at the foot of the page and then place the rest of the events in order on the road.
- 5 Illustrate at least some of the events with symbols and simple sketches.
- 6 Don't forget to give the road a title.
