Articles	Hapū ↓ Māori	Crown → NZ Government ↓ Tangata Tiriti
Article One: <i>kawanatanga</i>	Responsibility: To respect the right of the government to govern	
Article Two: <i>tino rangatiratanga</i> <i>land sales</i>	<p>Right: to retain control of all they value</p> <p>Right: all land sales voluntary</p> <p>Responsibility: for land sales to be managed by the government</p>	<p>Responsibility: to ensure hapū retain control of all they value</p> <p>Responsibility: Ensure land sales are voluntary</p> <p>Right: to manage land sales</p>
Article Three: <i>Māori rights</i>	Right: have the same rights and protections as British people	Responsibility: ensure Māori have the same rights and protections as British people
Article Four <i>protection of Māori customs</i>	Right: to have customs protected	Responsibility: to ensure Māori customs are protected
