For your assessment, you are required to create your own

brochure.

You choose the way of doing this: booklet, website, hard copy. In this brochure you are required to place a world map with a location for three world heritage sites. You will also add a **Title**, **a written description/explanation** as well as **photos and videos** if you wish.

Your challenge is to create a brochure for people who want to travel around the World. Your brochure has to include word heritage site that:

- Southern and Northern hemisphere,
- Proximity to the equator,
- Experience two contrasting seasons
- You must travel a minimum of 3 different time zone

Each location has to come with a explanation of:

- 1. Description of the site including if it is natural or cultural, tangible or intangible, justify your description.
- 2. Why is it a world heritage site?
- 3. What has been done to preserve this treasure?
- 4. Possible threats, recent or in the past
- 5. Identify at least ONE positive and ONE negative impact of this attraction (environmental/social/economic)
