Physical Properties

Here are some physical properties that you can use to describe an object.

Colour - has a particular colour eg red, silver, blue, orange, shiny, dull etc. or is colourless

Shape - round, square, symmetrical, irregular shape etc. or no shape

State - solid, liquid or gas

Smell - has a smell or is odourless (no smell)

Texture - smooth, hard, rough, bumpy, soft etc.

Amount - is measurable or not (can be counted or measured in some way)

Weight - has weight or is weightless

Volume - space it takes up
