- 2. A summary of your social impact enterprise plan: what, why, how, when, who? (80-150 words)
- 3. A sketch plan of your advertisement, showing what the layout looks like and specific techniques you will use for effect. Think about composition (how the different elements are organised for purpose and audience). Name and label.
- 4. A rationale of your advertisement design choices (80-150 words)
- 5. A reflection on how your enterprise could make a positive impact on the community (100-200 words)

Note: you can design your advertisement either online or on paper.
