Week 3 – The Week of August 9 to 15, 2021 Myths about Climate Change



Success Criteria

Students will become familiar with key myths that surround the concept of global warming and climate change and be able to explain one or two to their classmates in the form of a presentation.

Activities:

- 2. Writing
- 3. Class Discussion

Lesson 1: Preparing your Class Presentations

Students will be working in their groups, creating a short Powerpoint presentation on your chosen climate change myth. Most of the information that you will need will be under your chosen myth on the Skeptical Science website. All students in each group will participate in the class presentation. Remember, at the end of your Powerpoint you are going to include four short dot-point take-aways for other students to write down in their Red Books.
