

Aim: present a seminar on your reading of a poem

Seminar:

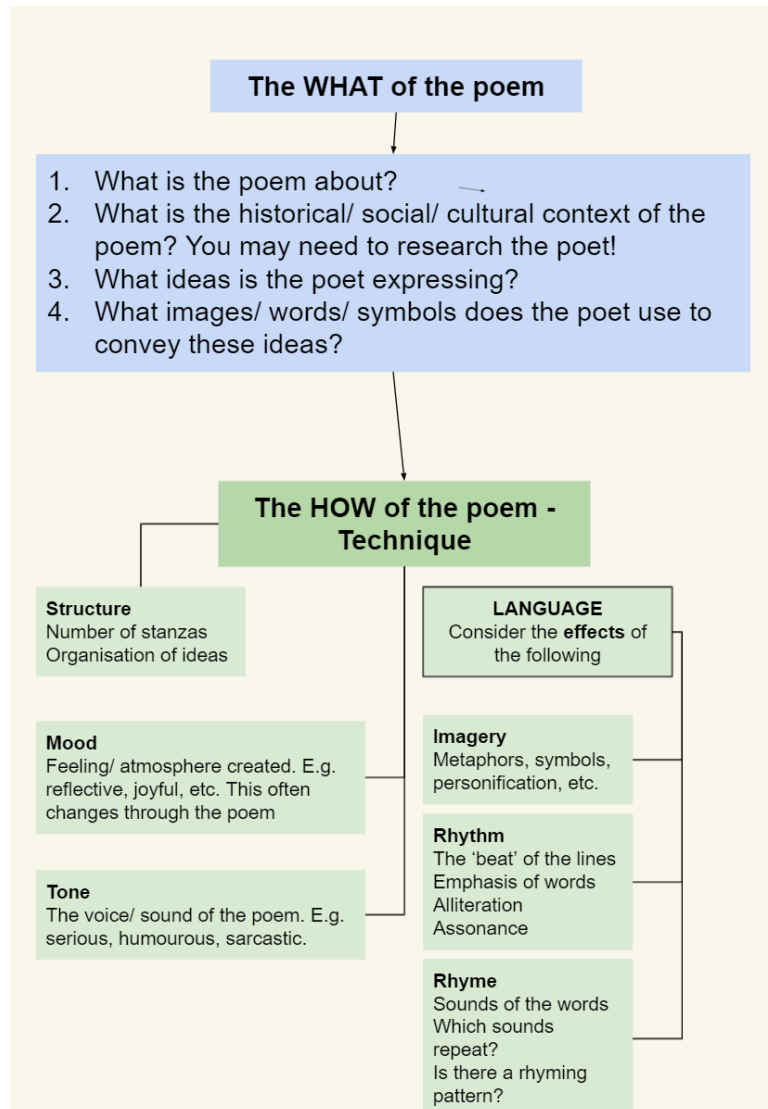
An interactive presentation to a small group of people, with space for questions to be asked/ discussion throughout.

- Your aim is to guide your group through a 10-15 minute presentation, during which they will take notes on the poem.
- You can use - handouts, pictures, etc.
- You should provide copies of the poem for each group member to annotate/ stick in to their books (Ms Wood will organise this once you advise A5/A4 etc)

Seminars will run on Tuesday of week 5.

During the session, you will run your seminar and then listen to two others, during which you will take notes on their poems and analysis.

1. Explore the poem that you have been assigned
2. Research the poet: why did they share this experience through poetry?
3. Then, explore the poem in more detail:



4. Prepare your presentation. Ensure you include space throughout for your audience to ask questions. Your presentation should last no longer than 15 minutes (not including space for audience questions).
 - a. ensure you plan for a reading through of the poem
 - b. as discussed, you can use your own annotations as a base for discussion
 - c. remember to include context (what is the time/place/context of this poem?)
 - d. poets are storytellers. What story are they telling and why?
 - e. what can we take from the experience they are sharing?
