CHARACTER ANALYSIS

Characters do many different things. Throughout a story a character will think things, wonder things, say things, hear things, love things, dislike things, and more! An author gives us these clues so that we can infer traits of this character. Who is this person? Are they friendly? Creative? Hateful? Determined? You can infer these traits based on something that someone does once in a story or on a pattern of behaviors. Use the graphic organizer below to record evidence from the text about the thoughts and actions of the character you are reading about. We will then use this evidence to help us infer traits.
