

4B4 PEH Assessment – Kiwiana Games

Your context this term in Coast is Kiwiana Fusion.

In PEH, we have begun by exploring the different games/sports/activities that make up Kiwi culture. For this assessment, you will continue to explore a select few of these activities and work to participate in these Kiwiana activities.

For this assessment, you will select one of the following activities that are part of Kiwiana. You must then film yourself (and family if you wish) participating in this Kiwiana game. Finally, using the resources provided, you must explain at the end of your video why this activity is considered to be Kiwiana and how it came to be (answer the questions below).

Remember Kiwiana . . . are certain items and icons from New Zealand's heritage, especially from around the middle of the 20th century, that are seen as representing iconic New Zealander elements. These "quirky things that contribute to a sense of nationhood" include both genuine cultural icons and kitsch.

This assessment will take place during Week 2, Term 4. It will be done entirely during distance learning.

To submit this assessment, you must save your video in your google drive and make it viewable to others. You will then upload your video link to MHO. This must be done by 4pm on Friday 29th October (the assessment due date)

You will be marked on the following criteria:

1.) Positive Attitude in a Kiwiana Activity

Demonstrate a willingness to learn new skills, accept a challenge, and step outside of your comfort zone through learning a new movement game and filming yourself in an activity below.

2.) Evaluation of Kiwiana activity

At the end of your video, answer the following questions about your activity. Information can be found on MHOL to help you with your understanding.

- When was this activity developed?
- Why is this activity considered a part of Kiwiana? Why do you think this?
