## PARAGRAPH 1:(COLOUR AND CONTRAST)

Colour and contrast is a powerful communication tool that is used to give the audience a deeper understanding of an image. Colour is such a vital part to static image which can significantly impact the way that it is perceived by a person. Certain colours have different meanings that can dramatically affect the moods, emotions and feelings that a character has on an image. I have used a contrast of blue and grey to symbolize two different extremes of lifestyle. In my static image the vibrant blue indicates a wealthy and more privileged environment, where people have social security in their lives. This means that an individual has essentials above and beyond things like water, food and housing. In comparison the sombre grey signifies a not so fortunate lifestyle, that is minimal and generally a struggle. I feel that my example is of relevance, as it clearly

explains why and how colour dictates and reflects my viewpoint. Metaphorically it relates colours to emotions. To conclude, colour and contrast plays a crucial aspect of a static image.

### PARAGRAPH 2:(DOMINANT IMAGE)

A dominant image provides a focus point for the audience. The image itself relates to the visual focal point of the static image. This unites both the theme and the subject matter. The image simply engages the audience and helps create a visual understanding. The key feature in my static image is a set of scales.
