Task

Choose a scene from a film to analyse.

INTRODUCTION (70 words)

- What is the film and who is the director?
- Briefly describe the scene in TWO sentences what happened?
- What was the director trying to achieve (purpose/theme/idea)?
- What are the four techniques that the director used to show this purpose?

BODY PARAGRAPHS (110 words) ×4

- **Statement** - What was the technique the director used?
- **Explain & Example** - What happened and how was the technique used in the scene (what did you see, hear, notice)?
- **Why** - Analyse this technique
 - How does your example show the director's purpose?
 - Does this relate to another part of the film? If so, how?
 - Why was this technique important?
 - How does this technique and another technique work together?

(Where possible, use more than one example to back up what you are saying)

CONCLUSION (70 words)

- Write a summary that refers back to the purpose and techniques.
- Say something insightful (interesting/mature)
 - Say something interesting about the main idea/theme.
 - Explain how the techniques work together to create meaning and communicate ideas in relation to the purpose, human experience, society, and the wider world.
