- Substitute values into equations to find total points for a game or series of games
- Remember in 1981 a Try was worth 4 points.
- A Conversion is worth 2 points, Penalties and Drop-Goals are worth 3 points.
- You can choose any three games to give your expressions, equations and terms.
- You will write your own judgment statement

4) Use your understanding of our context "Sports and Politics" and show any other way we can include Algebra in the context for this Term.
