

Based on the film 'Jojo Rabbit' answer the following questions:

1. Identify at least one important technique used in the text. Write an essay exploring how an idea in the text is presented to the reader/audience through the use of the technique/s. Note: Techniques could include
 - a. for written texts - figures of speech, syntax, word choice, style, symbolism, structure, or narrative point of view.
 - b. for visual texts - camera shots/ angles, costume, dialogue, etc
2. Identify a character who changed in the text you have studied. Write an essay exploring how and why the character changes by the end of the text. Consider decisions the character made and pivotal events.
3. **He waka eke noa** (we are all in this together – we rise together, fall together, work together, keep going together.) Write an essay exploring a relationship between characters and discuss how and why this relationship impacts on the reader/audience.
4. It is said that art often reflects life. Write an essay exploring how an idea/ideas in the text are relevant to readers/ audience in today's society.
5. **O le tele o sulu e maua ai figota** (through collaboration, the most difficult challenges can be overcome). Identify a challenge in the text you have studied. Write an essay exploring how the characters collaborate to overcome that challenge.
6. What Human Rights issues did you notice in the text? Are these issues still relevant in the present age?
7. Choose an important setting from the text. Why was this setting important? How did this setting impact the characters?
