Bake Sale Fundraiser Budget

WALT create simple budget Success Criteria I can plan a budget using given prices

The year 9 class decided to hold a bake sale to fundraise for their upcoming school camp. The students decided to make 100 cupcakes.

They can make the cupcakes from scratch with a recipe that makes 12 chocolate chip cupcakes per batch, or purchase chocolate cupcake mix that requires adding milk, egg and butter and makes 24.

Here is the list of items and the individual prices.
