Create a Static Image on an A4 Page

You can use Colour and Contrast, Font, Images, Graphic, lines etc and even Texture to promote a message you have unpacked from the 30 Hunan Rights Articles on MHJC

For this assessment you would need to write 3 paragraphs on any three techniques clearly stating how these techniques support your message. Each paragraph will be 120- 150 words written in TEXAS

Step 1 – Read all 30 Human Rights and find the Article that stands out to you (use more than 1 Article)

Step 2 – Link the Article with Modern Day Human Rights violations.

Step 3 – Find images and slogans to support your poster

Step 4 – Design your poster using the techniques unpacked (color / contrast / layout / font etc)

Step 5 – At the bottom list the human rights you have used to design your poster

I welcome abstract posters! But you will clearly unpack this in your writing

After the poster is designed and approved 3 x Sessions you will write on any 3 techniques (color / contrast / layout / font etc)
