Verbal and visual techniques employed in a film are important as they aid in the viewers understanding of key messages. In the film "HFTWP" by Taika Waititi the important idea of change and how to grow we must be change ready is well developed through techniques. The film is about a 13 year old foster child, Ricky Baker who is placed with Bella and Hec Faulkner to give him a second chance in life. Ricky for the first time experiences what it is like to be part of a family. The director uses the techniques of camera shots and angles, dialogue and lighting, diegetic and non-diegetic sounds to reinforce the message that in order to change we must be willing to give things a try.
