For our Term 2 context 'Tread lightly - Takahia Mana', Year 7 students in Wai Whanau have been exploring our **Native NZ environment**, and looking at *how humans can impact our environment*.

In this assessment, you are going to create an **infographic poster**, to present

information about this topic.

You will have **two weeks** of class time in Science and Global studies to complete your infographic

## Information to include in your infographic:

All must be written in your own words.

- 1. a) *Draw* a diagram of your chosen species, and *label* 2-5 of its structural adaptations
  - b) *Describe* how its structural and behavioural adaptations help it survive in its environment/habitat
- 2. a) *Identify* four threats to your species, and *define* how these threats impact your chosen species. **One** of these threats needs to be directly related to climate change.

b) Choose **one** of these threats to further *explain* in accurate detail. To do this, you will use a **labelled image** that clearly explains the impact of this threat on your chosen species. Assistance will be provided so that expectations of the labelled image are clear.

#### **Time in Class**

You will have two weeks of class time to complete the work. You can also work on it at home. You will need to talk to Ms. RB and Mr. Mitchell asap if you have a <u>legitimate</u> reason for why you cannot complete the assessment during this time - last minute requests will not be accepted.

## **Assessment Resources**

You will be given a selection of six species to choose from, all species that have in some way adapted to their environment. You will choose one of them for your assessment.

You will also be given a template that guides you through planning your infographic.
