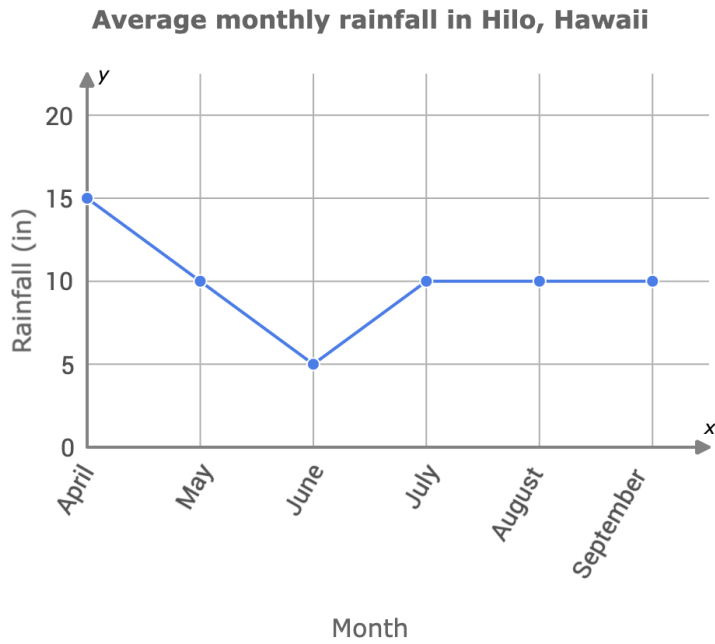


For a science project, students in Mr Walker's class displayed the amount of rainfall in Hilo, Hawaii, on a line graph.



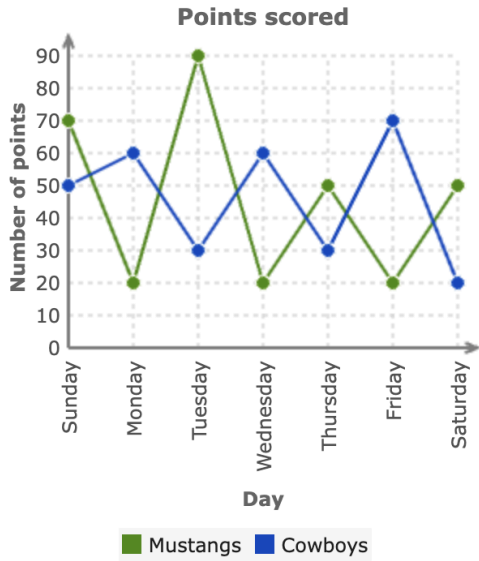
Which is the driest month on the graph?

On which day was the most bread left over?

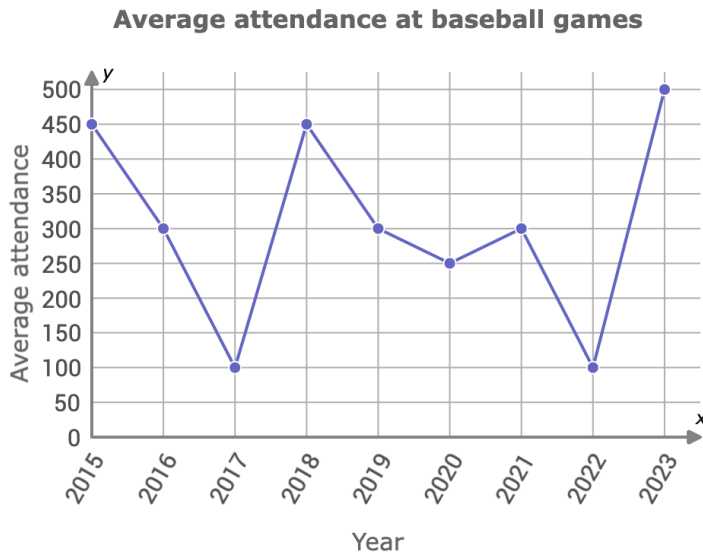
Sparrowtown hosted a major basketball tournament last weekend, and the results were reported in the local paper.

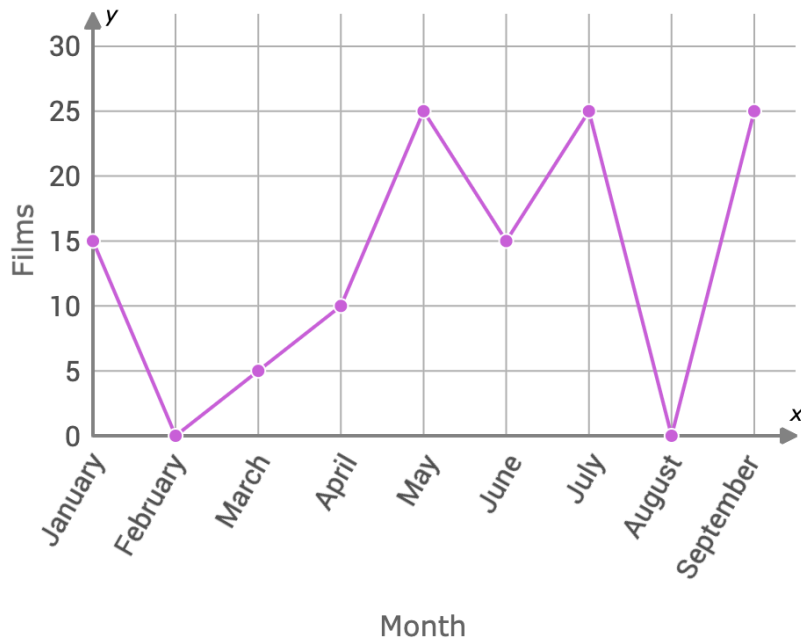
A local historian recorded the average annual attendance at baseball games in Broadwood each year.

In which month did Rina watch exactly 5 films?

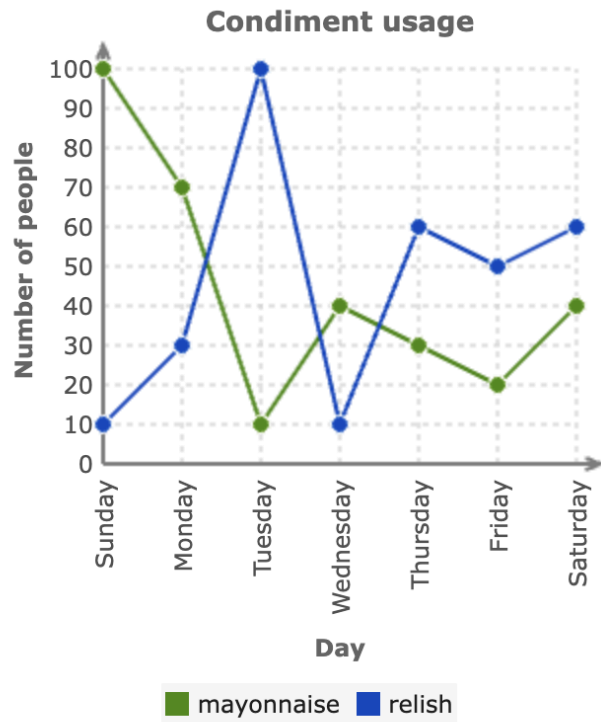

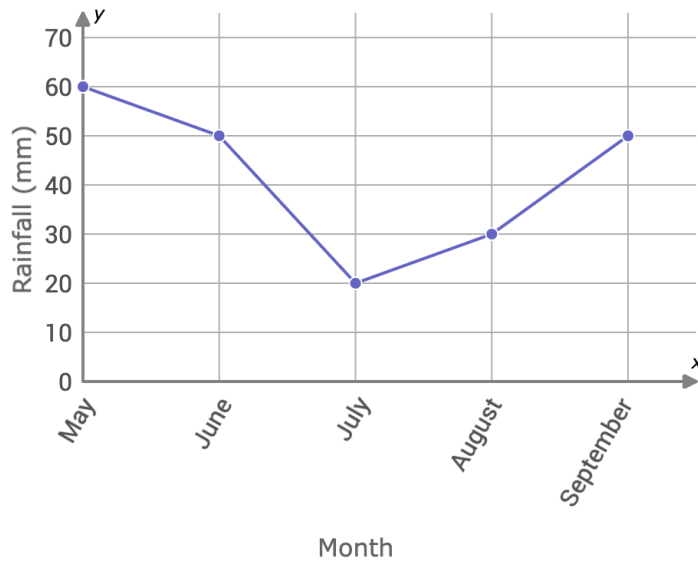

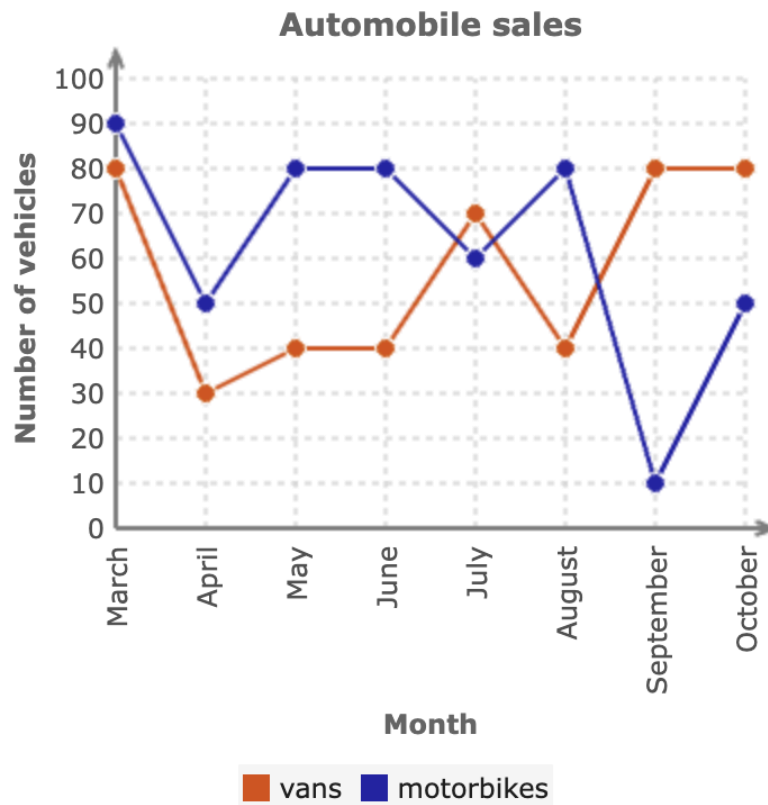
Average rainfall in Seattle

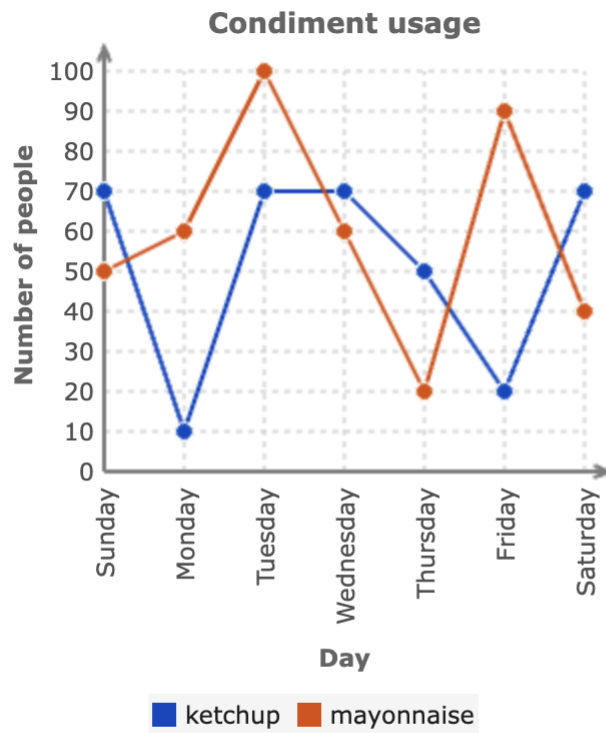


During March, were more vans or motorbikes sold?

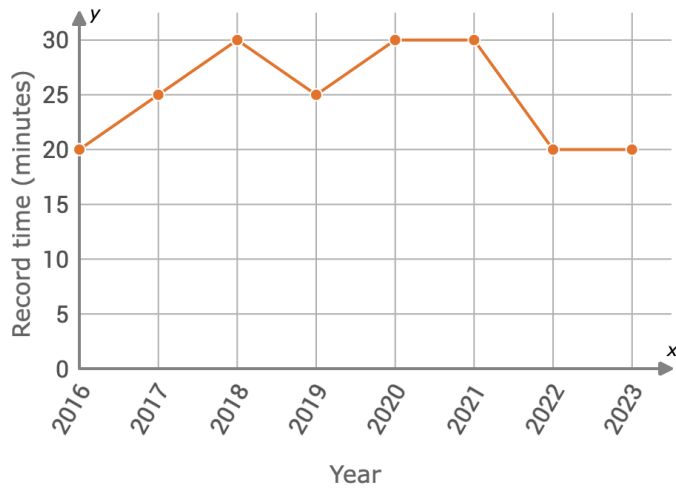

Record obstacle course completion times



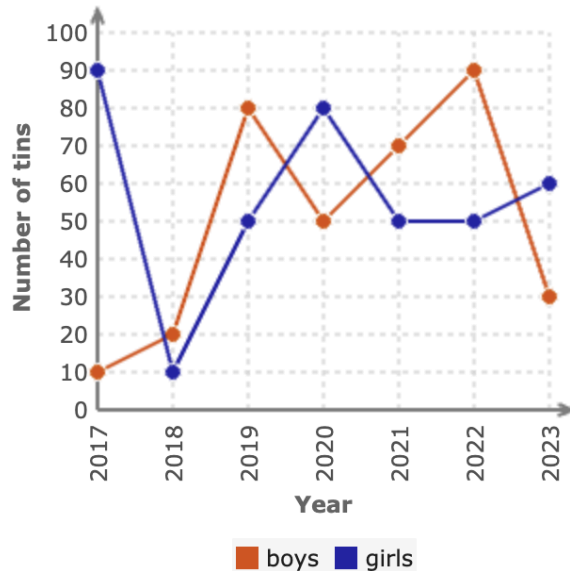
