Paragraph 1: Introduction	
<p><b>A) Attention-Getter/Hook:</b></p> <p>A statement/ sentence that gains attention and makes your audience sit up and listen</p> <p>You could use a: Quote/Joke/Fact/Joke/Story /An imagine scenario...</p>	<p><b>Write paragraph here...</b></p>
<p><b>B) Bond: Link-to Audience:</b></p> <p>Identify a personal connection in the audience's life - say why your topic is important to you and/or your audience</p>	
<p><b>c) Explain your Map to your Destination : Speech Preview:</b></p> <p>Briefly outline what you will cover in your speech. A bit like a trailer for a new film or the thesis to an essay</p>	
Body Paragraphs: 2,3,4	
<p>The body of your speech is where the detail is found, it is the three main points from your research template, each point is its own paragraph</p>	
<p><b>a) Paragraph 2 (Point #1)</b></p>	<p><b>Each body paragraph should include:</b></p> <p>Transitional sentence to first point,Joining sentence...this is how you move from one section or point to the next. It is a linking idea</p> <p><b>You could say ...</b> "Let's begin by ...", "Let's start with ..." or I prefer "Let's consider ...</p> <p>Your point</p>

	<p><i>The reason</i></p> <p><i>The example/ supporting evidence</i></p> <p><i>Restate the point</i></p> <p><i>Transitional sentence to your next point</i></p> <p><b><u>Paragraph here:</u></b></p>

<p><b>a) Restate your idea:</b> possibly point out why your idea is so important</p> <p><b>b) Restate main points:</b> show how the evidence you have given proves your point</p> <p><b>c) Call-to-Action or a message to leave your audience with</b></p>	<b>Write paragraph here...</b>
