drama	Arm and hand movements to show expression
gesture	A camera is mounted to this vehicle or trolley
SFX	A play intended for acting on a stage
close up	A lens that can move the subject closer or further away
props	Special effects
mime	A close shot of the subject being filmed
zoom	Articles and items used by the actors on the stage or film set
dolly	Movement and acting without words
dialogue	Character talk
tilt	When the camera moves vertically up and down
characters	People in a play, TV drama film or story
medium shot	A shot that reveals more of the subject
