

Assessment 2: Implement Basic Procedures using Textile Materials.

You are to construct your Boxers or Sweatshirt and provide evidence of your technique implementation.

This includes:

Boxers - Pattern selection, Pattern placement on fabric, Cutting out, Plain Seam, Neatening, Curved Seam, Casing and Hemming.

Sweatshirt - Pattern selection, Pattern placement on fabric, Cutting out, Plain Seam, Neatening, Attaching Rib trim, Hemming

Evidence can be in the form of pictures of your sewn technique/ procedure and / or your finished Boxers/Sweatshirt.

There will also be teacher observation in class of your implementation.
