2a). Plan Your 'Around the World' Trip on a Spreadsheet

Requirements:	Added to Itinerary
Your travel plans must be formatted as an Itinerary on Sheet 1 , and a running log of Expenditure on Sheet 2 :	
Your itinerary must start at the Waitangi Treaty Grounds in the Bay of Islands , then travel through Goat Island Marine Reserve before heading overseas;	Yes or No

Your itinerary must include a visit to the Globe Theatre, London . This theatre was built in 1599 by William Shakespeare's playing company;	Yes or No
Your itinerary must include at least 1 attraction/activity from each categories listed: World Heritage Site, natural attraction, animal attraction/activity, cultural attraction, sporting event/activity, cultural event/activity, adventure tourism activity, eco-tourism attraction/activity;	Yes or No
In your itinerary you must visit at least 3 Tourist Attractions that are under threat by man-made causes: ie global warming/climate change, CO2 emissions, deforestation, combustion, over-fishing;	Yes or No
You must include in your itinerary, destinations that are in the Southern and Northern hemisphere, a destination that is in close proximity to the equator, experience of destinations in two contrasting seasons;	
You need to meet up with different friends in the other class on at least 3 different occasions (this collaboration/organisation can not be done face to face but through a digital platform - skype, messaging etc;	Yes or No
In your travel itinerary you must use at least 3 different currencies;	Yes or No
Your itinerary must identify (list) the sightseeing attractions/activities you will visit/participate and these must link to your Google Site;	Yes or No
