

<p><b>Point</b></p>	<p>State the point you are discussing for the whole paragraph. Key words from the question. What is the paragraph about?</p>
<p><b>Explain</b></p>	<p>Explaining the <b>context</b> of your topic. Give <b>two</b> or <b>three</b> facts about your topic to show that you know your stuff.</p>
<p><b>Example/Evidence</b></p>	<p>Giving an <b>example</b> to <b>illustrate</b> the point that you have made. You might discuss a short case study, give a quote and discuss it, talk about key facts and figures. Any of these will do.</p>
<p><b>Link it back to the Point/Your Opinion</b></p>	<p>Why? / So what? Why is this significant? What are the consequences? [wider world]</p> <p>Link back to your question / statement sentence.</p> <p>End your paragraph by making a statement that <b>supports</b> what you have said in your paragraph.</p> <p>Show <b>how</b> all these things relate back to your point or your question.</p>
